



FLUOR STEM AWARDS

This award was created by Fluor Canada to support two Centennial students pursuing an Engineering, Engineering Technology or STEM-related Career at a Canadian Post-Secondary program.

DONOR: Fluor Canada

WHERE TENABLE: Centennial High School

FIELD OF STUDY: Engineering, Engineering Technology or STEM-related Career

VALUE: \$1,000

NUMBER: Two

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must have grades appropriate to their chosen post secondary course. Applicants must have made or are making positive contributions to the community or school through service or extracurricular activities, embodying a well-rounded nature.

Applicants must also submit an essay/statement of approximately 500 words explaining why they are interested in a career path in STEM/Engineering/Engineering technology, and post-secondary plans.

Consideration may also be given to students demonstrating financial need; students with financial need should provide a separate “statement of financial need” explaining their financial situation/circumstances

APPLY: Students can apply by creating an account in EducationMatters’ [Student Award Application Portal](#). Applicants should check with their guidance office for more information and are encouraged to discuss their application with the Scholarship Coordinator at their high school.

SELECTION & PAYMENT: Recipients will be notified by September. The selection committee shall be made up of Centennial staff including a representative from EducationMatters. To claim the award, the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study in Canada in the Fall of 2026. Payments are made to the post-secondary institution upon proof of registration.
